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I. PROJECT

1. Project objectives

Main objective of the project was dissemination of good practices related to the mobility of students, academic and administrative staff members, as well as developing of theses and assumptions to be followed supporting international student mobility between universities.

Cooperation of the universities within the project aimed at widening and developing knowledge, skills and competencies of project participants, especially in the field of:

- increasing professional competencies,
- increasing their self-esteem and self-confidence,
- improving foreign language proficiency,
- developing key social competences due to the cooperation in international environment,
- increasing attractiveness in workplace and labour market,
- improving teaching skills (teachers),
- enriching materials and educational aids.

Cooperation within the project is also aimed at:

- developing and realisation of international strategy of participating universities,
- increasing of education level and quality,
- comparing and improving of educational curricula, and in case of Partner Universities, adjusting educational programs to European standards - Benchmarking
- working on common educational programmes for master's students,
- preparing of programmes for double diplomas with Partner Universities,
- developing and exchange of cooperation proposals in the field of research activities which can result in international scientific projects and joint scientific publications.

Exchange of experience and good practices contributed to developing and disseminating ideas about studying abroad, indicating sources of funding for academic international exchange, representing of good practices developed in the Universities.

Problems related to social, legal, environmental barriers and ways of their solution have also been discussed.

Cooperation between the Universities definitely contributed to increase of their prestige on regional and local educational markets.

2. Participating universities

a. Poland

- **Wyższa Szkoła Ekologii i Zarządzania w Warszawie**
(University of Ecology and Management in Warsaw)



University of Ecology and Management in Warsaw (UEM) is one of the best private technical – artistic universities in Poland. UEM, established upon the decision of the Ministry of National Education of 18 July 1995 and registered under number 62, more than 25 years conducts education on full time and part time bachelors and masters studies.

Education at the University is conducted within two Faculties: Faculty of Architecture and Faculty of Engineering and Management, on which it is possible to study on 10 fields of studies.

Mission of University of Ecology and Management in Warsaw is high quality, modern and flexible education of studies:

- ready to meet the developmental needs of information society and the knowledge-based economy,
- enriching with their professionalism and intellectual mobility human capital of Masovia, Poland and EU,
- creating new economic, social and cultural values in the spirit of idea of sustainable development, according to expectations of current and future labor market.

University authorities pay attention to the high level of education hiring more than 300 specialists from different fields. Lecturers of UEM are not only scientific workers of other universities in Warsaw, but also practitioners possessing business experience. Due to combination of knowledge of lecturers and representatives of Faculty Councils of Employers, with whom programmes of studies are being discussed (according to European standards), studies in UEM are interdisciplinary, combine theory with practices, due to which are conducted with the application of design approach, teach students independence and ability to take responsible decisions.

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b. Armenia

(National University of Architecture and Construction of Armenia)



The National University of Architecture and Construction of Armenia (NUACA) is a higher school of Architecture and Construction that was founded in Yerevan in 1921. It is a technical school which has been in operation for nearly 100 years. The university consists of five faculties: Architecture, Design, Construction, Urban Economy and Ecology, and Management and Technology. Moreover, NUACA is the only university in Armenia preparing architects and construction engineers.

The internationalisation strategy of NUACA testifies its strong commitment to the promotion of sustainable development of international relations for educational, scientific, and technical cooperation. The strategy also includes actions to develop the cooperation with architectural and construction-oriented universities abroad, intending to organise joint conferences, student project weeks, contests, and the promotion of academic mobility of teaching staff and students.

NUACA has participated in 17 TEMPUS, Erasmus Mundus, and currently Erasmus+ projects. Three Erasmus+ KA2 projects are ongoing: HERITAG, InnoCENS, and Iacobus+. As well as two KA1 projects with Universidade de Lisboa and the University of Alcalá are currently active. NUACA has accomplished some EU-funded mobility projects: Erasmus Mundus Infinity project and Erasmus+ KA1 with the Polytechnic University of Milan.

Besides, NUACA is actively implementing student exchange projects in the framework of Cooperation Agreements signed with European partner Higher Educational Institutions from Poland, Spain, Udine, etc.

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Azerbaijan

- **Azərbaycan Texnologiya Universiteti**
(Azerbaijan Technological University)



The Azerbaijan University of Technology (UTECA) was founded in complying with the execution of the Decree of the President of the Azerbaijan Republic dated 13.06.2000 on "Improvement of the Education System in the Republic of Azerbaijan" via expanding the branches of the Azerbaijan Technological Institute by the order No. 691 of the Minister of Education of the Azerbaijan Republic dated 11.07.2000.

The UTECA was established on the initiative of the National Leader Haydar Aliyev based on the Kirovabad branch of the Azerbaijan Polytechnic Institute named after Ch. Ildirim through adjoining the Baku branch of the Krasnodar Polytechnic Institute and "Technology of wine making" specialization of the Azerbaijan Agricultural Institute by the decision of the Council of Ministers of the USSR №202 dated 22.02.1979 according to the edict №206 issued on 10.07.1980 by the Council of Ministers of the Az SSR.

The Azerbaijan University of Technology was awarded the Honorary Decree of the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Special Education of the Azerbaijan SSR and the Republican Trade Union Committee due to winning second place in the competition held in 1982 among the universities of the Republic paired with occupying the first place in 1983-1984. Meanwhile, in 1984 the University was awarded the Red Cross Banner of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Azerbaijan, the Council of Ministers of the Azerbaijan SSR, and the LC G C of Azerbaijan.

Currently, there are 4 faculties, 17 departments, postgraduate and graduate departments, scientific research division, preparation course, two scientific research laboratories, English Language Resource Center, library, Information Computing Center, medical center, 3 catering, 4 production-experimental facilities, gym (area 1000 sq. m) and student campus.

The UTECA is preparing highly qualified engineers and technologists in the fields of food, textile and light industry, tourism, logistics, metallurgy, ICT technicians. Scientific researchers at the university are mainly focused on the directions of environment, technology, and engineering economics.

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c. China

▪ **山东建筑大学**

(Shandong Jianzhu University)



The Shandong Jianzhu University (SJZU), which was jointly established by Shandong Province and the Ministry of Housing and Urban-Rural Development, was founded in 1956. The University currently has more than 27,000 full-time students (including more than 200 international students). SJZU is located in Shandong Province, the birthplace of Confucian culture. Shandong is an important province in terms of culture and economy on the east coast of China.

The SJZU has become a well-known university with a long history, profound cultural heritage, strong academic strength, and extensive international influence. It is an ideal institution for students at home and abroad to pursue further study.

The campus covers a land area of more than 160 hectares, with a building area of more than 660,000 square meters. The university includes 20 schools and 4 institutes. It provides 58 undergraduate programmes, 1 postdoctoral programme, 1 PhD programme, 17 first-level master's programmes, 62 second-level master's programmes, and 9 professional master's programmes.

The university is also one of the first authorized universities that are eligible to recruit international students in China. The university attaches profound importance to international exchanges and cooperation. With an open mind, the university has established partnerships with more than 80 universities from over 30 countries and regions, including Australia, the USA, New Zealand, the UK, Canada, and so on. Currently, eight undergraduate joint programmes and more than 20 students exchange programmes have been established.

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d. Kazakhstan

- **Семейқаласының Шәкәрім атындағы мемлекеттік университеті**

(Shakarim State University of Semey)



Shakarim University was established in 1995 as a result of the integration of Pedagogical, Veterinary, and Technological Institutes. The University inherited the long and rich history of those educational institutions.

The University trains the specialists of the broad spectrum of acclaimed professions in the areas such as socio-humanitarian, natural, technical, agricultural sciences, business, and law based on multilevel preparation of more than 40 bachelors, 30 master, and 5 PhD programmes.

The University closely co-operates with Institutions of Higher Education in Russia, Germany, the Republic of Belarus, the USA, Japan, Great Britain, China, Hungary, Turkey, Poland, Slovenia, the Baltic States, Ukraine, and Kyrgyzstan. Academic mobility programs give opportunities to the students of Shakarim State University to study at the universities of the USA, Hungary, Poland, Turkey, Czech Republic, and South Korea.

The Shakarim State University of Semey is one of the largest multidisciplinary universities in Kazakhstan. University is on the 10th position in the rank of all multidisciplinary universities of Kazakhstan according to the results of educational activities evaluation conducted by the National Accreditation Centre of the Ministry of Education and Science in 2008.

The university is awarded the Republican and International prizes for the outstanding results of its educational activity.

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e. Kosovo

- **Universiteti i Shkencave Aplikuara ne Ferizaj**
(University of Applied Sciences in Ferizaj)



University of Applied Sciences in Ferizaj (UASF) was established in July 2015 by the Parliament of the Republic of Kosovo following a 40-year tradition of professional and applied science education of the Faculty of Applied Sciences in Ferizaj, part of the University of Prishtina.

With the decision of the Assembly of Kosovo in July 2015 was establish University of Applied Sciences which since then operate 4 faculties:

- Faculty of Management,
- Faculty of Tourism and Environment,
- Faculty of Engineering with Informatics,
- Faculty of Architecture, Design and Wood Technology.

Their mission is to work along with the students and staff alike to develop collaborative activities with local partners (by involving them in the development process of the University) as well as foreign partners (European universities of applied sciences, etc.) through the mobilisation of students and teachers, for the purpose to utilise all internal resources (human and material) to create a sustainable link between local and regional economic needs and the permanent growth of quality education.

The vision is to become the largest and reputable institution in the region specialised in applied science as well as higher professional education programmes in several areas and expertise, to provide trained and highly qualified professionals to local as well as regional businesses and industries.

Currently at University are studying 1790 students in bachelor and master programmes. There are 61 professors, and 8 administrative staff employees. The number of graduates so far is over 2500.

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f. Serbia

- **Универзитету Нишу**
(University of Niš)



The University of Niš is a modern and recognizable Serbian and European university that is comparable to foreign higher education institutions of the highest rank in terms of quality of study programs, teaching activities, research, and professional work.

Research work is performed at all faculties of the University of Niš, in the areas of basic, applied and development scientific research. Research supports the development of science and creativity, improves higher education activities through the improvement of the teaching process, advancement of young scientists, the inclusion of students into the academic work, as well as by providing the resources for work and development of the university as a whole. Research work in the previous period has been carried out through the participation of the teaching staff in the realisation of national and international research projects, publishing papers in academic journals, and attending academic seminars in the country and abroad. The University of Niš consists of 13 faculties and 9 centres.

In conformity with the Law on Higher Education and by the decisions of the Commission for Accreditation and Quality Assurance of the Republic of Serbia, all the faculties of the University of Niš have been accredited.

From the University foundation until the academic year 2018/2019, 73312 students have graduated from the University of Niš, 1383 of them being foreign citizens, while 7429 postgraduates acquired their magister degrees and 2207 candidates, including 73 foreigners, defended their doctoral dissertations.

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g. Ukraine

- **Сумський державний університет**
(Sumy State University)



The Sumy State University (SSU) is a higher education institution of classical type located in the city of Sumy, North-Eastern part of Ukraine. SSU currently serves about 14000 students who are pursuing bachelor and master degrees in 54 majors and 22 fields of knowledge. About 1700 foreign students represent almost 50 countries worldwide.

The Sumy State University is included in Global Research University Profiles (GRUP) by Shanghai Ranking. SSU is also included in the directory of the world's best universities by the Times Higher Education World University Rankings. Sumy State University enters the TOP-group (3%) of leading universities of the world and is classified as a university with high research intensity according to the international ranking of higher education institutions QS World University Rankings.

SSU is a signatory of Magna Charta Universitatum and a reliable member of most authoritative international organizations- International Association of Universities, European University Association, Eurasian Universities Association, etc. SSU cooperates with more than 260 partners from the USA, Great Britain, Germany, Austria, France, Belgium, Sweden, Poland, Lithuania, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Slovakia, Romania, Japan, South Korea, China, and other countries of the world.

SSU is a reliable partner for joint projects in frames of international grant programmes of EU (BUP, Jean Monnet, Erasmus+, Horizon 2020), United Nation Development Programme, British Council, the World Bank, bilateral scientific and research projects, grants of private foundations. The University accomplishes more than 250 grants annually. For the last 5 years, the amount of research work in frames of international grant projects has increased by 20 times.

The University actively develops academic mobility programmes, including long-term and short-term studying, internships and placement programmes for undergraduate and postgraduate students, research and teaching staff, as well as administrative staff using technologies of credit transfer and recognition of academic results.

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- **Національний університет біоресурсів і природокористування України**
(National University of Environmental and Life Sciences of Ukraine)



The National University of Life and Environmental Sciences of Ukraine is one of the leading institutions of education, science, and culture in Ukraine. More than 26 thousand students and more than 600 graduates, PhD students, and seekers study at 3 educational and research institutes and 13 departments of basic university institution (in Kyiv) and 10 separate units of NULES of Ukraine – regional universities of I-III accreditation levels. Educational process and scientific research at the University are provided by more than 2,600 scientific and educational and pedagogical workers, including about 300 professors and doctors of sciences, more than 1,000 assistant professors, and PhDs.

The National University of Life and Environmental Sciences of Ukraine strengthens its leadership positions in the field of international activity from year to year. NULES of Ukraine participates actively in international programs of higher education, helps foreign countries to prepare their national staff for agriculture.

Study at the National University of Life and Environmental science of Ukraine is based on international agreements of Ukraine, national programs, treaties with legal entities, and individuals. Nowadays citizens of Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Iraq, Iran, Kazakhstan, Cyprus, Lebanon, Morocco, Palestine, Poland, Russia, Slovakia, USA, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, and the Czech Republic study at NULES of Ukraine. Close cooperation with leading universities around the world contributed to the reform and adaptation of the education system of NULES of Ukraine to the requirements of leading universities.

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- **Киевский политехнический институт имени Игоря Сикорского**

(National Technical University of Ukraine “Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute”)



Kyiv Polytechnic Institute (since 2016 – National Technical University of Ukraine “Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute”) was founded in 1898 and is one of the oldest technical universities of Ukraine, Europe, and the world.

At present, Igor Sikorsky KPI is a national autonomous state higher education institution of research type. Igor Sikorsky KPI educates students in different areas of economics and the social sphere, 118 specialties in general. They train candidates (Ph.D.) and doctors (D.Sc.) in priority areas: Energy, Engineering, Information Technology, Information Security, Electronics, Telecommunications, Space Systems, Chemical Technology, and Biotechnology.

The training process is carried out by experienced teachers and well-known NASU scientists. Igor Sikorsky KPI comprised 19 faculties, 19 faculties, 9 educational and scientific institutes, several scientific and research institutes, and educational centres, in which more than 21 000 students are training. KPI employs more than 500 professors and over 1300 associate professors.

Igor Sikorsky KPI has trained 370 thousand graduates over its history of 117 years, 60 thousand of which during the period of Ukrainian independence. KPI ranks 4% of the best universities of the world according to the international rating QS and Webometrics. It annually holds the highest positions among the best higher educational establishments of Ukraine – “Compass” and “TOP-200 Ukraine”.

Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute cooperates with technical universities of dozens of world countries, a lot of international organisations (UNESCO, UNIDO, WIPO, NATO, EDNES, ICSU, CODATA, etc.) and the most leading corporations and firms (SIEMENS, FESTO, SAMSUNG, INTEL, etc.), takes part in international educational, scientific projects and programmes.

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- **Бердянський Університет Менеджменту і Бізнесу**
(Berdyansk University of Management and Business)



Berdyansk University of Management and Business (BUMIB) is a private higher education institution located in the city of Berdyansk. It was one of the first private higher education institutions in its region created to train specialists to work in market economy conditions.

The Institution trained its first specialists in the field of Economy, Management, Law, Sociology, Business Administration, and Information Technology. In 1998 the University was accredited by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine as a private higher education institution with the right to give diplomas in a standard state format.

Nowadays, four faculties (Economic Department, Management and Business Department, Information Technology Department, and Law Department) have trained more than 8000 students of all forms of education in 16 specialties of professional-level education. BUMIB was the first of Berdyansk education institutions that organised training of the highly skilled engineering staff.

Nowadays the University is cooperating with universities from Germany, France, Bulgaria, Turkey, Russia, the Czech Republic, Poland, and other countries.

University of Ecology and Management in Warsaw within the project from 01.06.2018 to 31.07.2021 hosted in total 18 students, teaching and administrative staff members:

- five students – 1 student from the National University of Architecture and Construction of Armenia, 1 student from the Azerbaijan Technological University, 1 student from the University of Applied Sciences in Ferizaj, 1 student from the University of Niš and 1 student from the National Technical University of Ukraine “Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute”;
- six academic staff members – 1 from the Azerbaijan Technological University, 1 from the Shakarim State University of Semey, 1 from the University of Applied Sciences in Ferizaj, 1 from the University of Niš, 1 from the National University of Environmental and Life Sciences of Ukraine, 1 from the Berdyansk University of Management and Business;
- seven administrative staff members – 2 from the National University of Architecture and Construction of Armenia, 2 from the Shakarim State University of Semey, 1 from the University of Applied Sciences in Ferizaj, 1 from the University of Niš, 1 from the Sumy State University.

Five academic staff members of UEM conducted lectures for students of Partner Universities – 2 in the National University of Architecture and Construction of Armenia, 1 in the Azerbaijan Technological University, 1 in the University of Applied Sciences in Ferizaj, and 1 in the University of Niš.

Two administrative staff members of UEM took part in training or job shadowing organised by Partner Universities – 1 in the University of Niš, 1 in the National Technical University of Ukraine “Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute”.

It is also worth mentioning that on 24-28 June 2019 the University of Ecology and Management in Warsaw organised Staff Week for representatives from Partner Universities, which was devoted to the issues concerning education systems in Poland and Partner Countries, quality assurance in education - external and internal instruments, structure and scope of tasks of the most important units at universities, possibilities of educational and research cooperation

between Partner Universities, plans concerning further cooperation within Erasmus+ Programme and dissemination of results of projects KA-107 2016, 2017, 2018 within Erasmus+ Programme. During the Staff Week representatives of Partner Universities shared good practices and discussed main problems during realisation of projects.

This event has strongly contributed to:

- development and realisation of the internationalisation strategy of Partner Universities;
- learning the structure, organisational culture, and way of operating of the Partner Universities;
- exchange of experiences related to structures, mechanisms and improving the quality of education and quality assurance tools;
- improving the quality of education and services provided for students;
- improving procedures and support mechanisms for the international exchange of students, staff, and teachers between Universities;
- developing and exchanging ideas for cooperation within research and development activities;
- facilitating further integration of the Universities from Partner Countries with the European Higher Education Area;
- exchange of good practices connected with breaking social, legal, and environmental barriers of cooperation;
- promoting intercultural communication and a better understanding of European values.

The visit to Azerbaijan Technological University in Ganja took place from 20th to 24th May 2019. The main aim of the mobility was to conduct teaching activities to improve students' proficiency in methodology and research techniques, as well as to share with colleagues from Azerbaijan the competencies in the area of quality assurance in higher education.

My stay in Azerbaijan started in Baku, a city with extraordinary architecture, a mixture of history, and impressive modern buildings designed by the world's best architects, e.g. Zaha Hadid. There is also an important Polish trace here, as at the beginning of the 20th century three Polish architects held the position of the chief architect of the city of Baku.

The main part of my mobility was at Azerbaijan Technological University in Ganja. Here I gave two lectures focused on improving students' skills in data collection and methods of solving research problems. In addition, I conducted a seminar for teaching staff on the Polish higher education system. The meetings were attended by



both students and academic staff of the university. They were held in the form of workshops rather than a traditional lecture, with a lot of group work, student presentations, and lecturers evaluations. This was very well received by the participants, as the majority of classes at their university are conducted in lecture form, while they wanted more active methods.

The classes I conducted with the students and teaching staff were a pleasant and valuable experience for me – almost all participants were open and active, eager to work in teams.

Apart from teaching, I had the chance to watch the graduation ceremony and interact with students in an informal way. In Azerbaijan it is prohibited to take pictures of women without their permission, however, it does not mean that they do not want to be photographed!



The mobility was an opportunity not only to meet people represented different culture but also to see the extremely interesting surroundings of Baku (mud volcanoes, a gorge forming a remnant of the Caspian Sea) and the charming mountain lake Goygolnear Ganja, located close but already in the neighbourhood of a militarised zone. Even then, the smouldering Azeri-Armenian conflict was already casting a shadow over the daily lives of these people. Unfortunately, soon after I left, it escalated into bloody clashes.

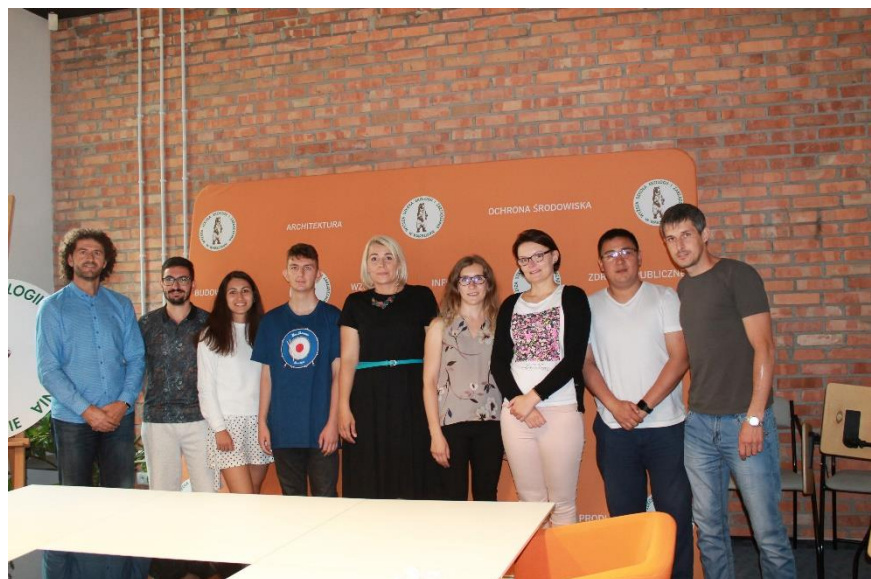
