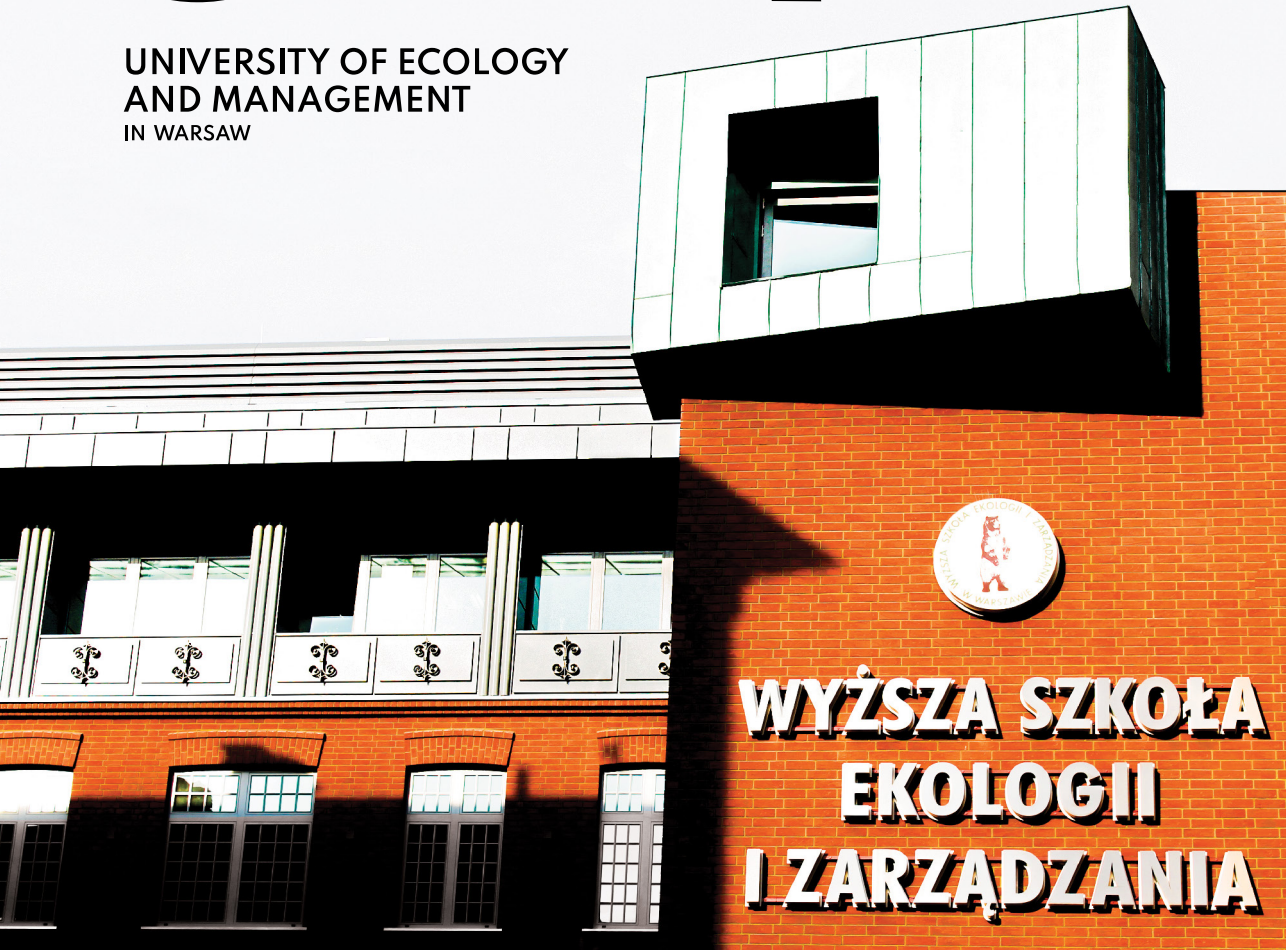

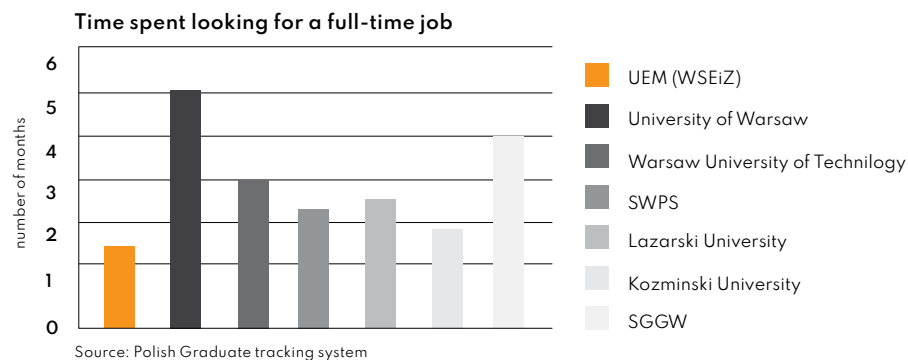

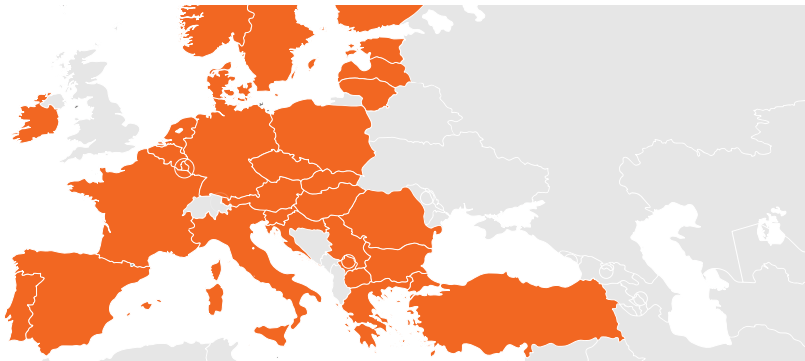

# International cooperation



The Erasmus+ program enables international exchange between partner universities located in the European Union and beyond. Through participation in the program, it is possible to co-finance student trips for exchange studies and internships. Countries participating in the program: 27 European Union Member States, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, the Republic of North Macedonia, Serbia, and Turkey.



## Double diploma

In addition to the Polish bachelor's degree, by studying Management at UEM you can obtain the American Bachelor of Science in Business Management diploma issued by Herzing University (USA).

The American Bachelor of Science degree is obtained after only one year of study at this University. After completing the studies in the USA, graduates can apply for a visa extension for one year and work under the so-called Optional Practical Training.

Admission: May 1st – Sep

Summer semester  
(classes start in March)  
Admission: Dec 1st – Feb
